## **Minutes of the Annual Meeting**

### **3 May 1997**

Meeting is called to order by John McDonough at The Epicurean restaurant in Bar Harbor at 1930 hours.

#### **Present**

Attendees numbered approximately 75 from SAR units throughout the state. Also present were the officers from the past year with the exception of Randy Armour.

#### **Elections**
