NRA Basic Pistol Course

Concealed Carry Course Certificate (This is recognized to remove Restrictions from permit returning full privileges to permit holder)

Persons Joining NRA, NYSRPA or Iroquois Sportsmen's Club will receive 10% discount on the course upon paid membership fee on first night of class.

Card Carrying Military or LEO's will receive 15% discount

NOTE: only one discount will be applied per-person.

Course Student Requirements

- 1: Pistol License
- 2: Notepad, Pen and #2 pencil
- 3: Baseball style hat with brim
- 4: Eye Protection wrap around style Z87 rated
- 5: Hearing protection/ear plugs
- 6: Firearm intended as primary concealed carry firearm
- 7: 200 rounds of factory ammo for your pistol
- 8: Belt mounted or paddle concealment, purse style holsters only
- 9: Loose fitting concealment garment(vest or jacket)
- 10: 3 appropriate mags/ speedloaders for your firearm with belt holder
- 11: Lunch: inquire from instructor what is required

Candidates must safely and successfully attend all course sessions, successful completion of both academic and Practical phases in order to receive both certificates. If only the academic portion is completed successfully candidate will receive the NRA Basic Pistol course certificate.

Safe and Successful completion Pass/Fail of practical phase is at the discretion of the lead instructor/range safety officer. There is a minimum qualification course of fire required to pass safe proficiency evaluation. Recurring firearms safety violations are grounds for immediate practical course failure. Decisions are final for that session, retaking of practical session is allowed at another date.
